FILL THE GAP: In Their Hands



For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires."

Abigail was devoted to God's Word.

Ever since someone from ShareWord Global came to her classroom. shared the gospel with her—and left her with her own Bible, she could not put it down.

She carried it with her to school. She poured over its words at home. She was so committed to the Word, that her mom, who was not a Christian, started to worry.

"What has my daughter gotten into?" she thought to herself.

Intent on finding fault in her daughter's new beliefs, she started attending the church—the church that had shared the Bible with her daughter.

After two months of trying to find anything she could accuse the church of, Abigail's mom came to a different conviction: What they were saying was the truth!

Instead of pulling her daughter away from the church, she confessed faith in Jesus and now both Abigail and her mom attend regularly.

This is the power of God's Word to transform lives. It can open closed doors and change the hardest of hearts.



FILL THE GAP: In Their Hearts



Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart..."

Chakupewa grew up in a Christian home but had never truly accepted Jesus into her heart.

Instead, she sought to fill that gap with other things. She entered a relationship with a married man, eventually becoming his wife and following him into a local traditional cult. But neither her new husband nor the cult was able to satisfy.

When her husband died suddenly, Chakupewa felt lost, and fled with her family from their home in Zimbabwe to Malawi.

And the hole in her heart grew.

When still harder times came, she sought refuge in a camp where she met a man she recognized from the cult she had been a part of.

She asked him for help, and while he gave it, through him, she was once again drawn into the emptiness of the cult that had never satisfied her.

So, when she heard about a ShareWord Global Ignite Event in the camp she was interested...and nervous.

"There's no way they will accept me," she thought.

Despite her nerves, Chakupewa attended the event. While there, she was struck by the passion for the gospel she saw, and the Good News she heard being spoken by the Christians.

The redemptive power of Christ and His message of hope echoed inside her, filling the hole that she had for so long looked to fill on her own.

"This is what I have been missing!" she proclaimed.

Chakupewa made a decision right then and there that would change her life forever. The decision to make Jesus Lord of her life. Now she no longer has to seek comfort, purpose, or validation from others.

The gap in her heart was filled—by Jesus.





FILL THE GAP: In The Pews

They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.

It's the gap that's easiest to see. Most of us see it every week.

The empty chairs or pews in churches. The void that represents a soul who has not yet found Christ. It's a gap every single believer wants to fill.

And over the last year, by walking alongside churches in Canada, the USA, and around the world, you've done just that!

"I see this having a tremendous impact. There are well over 150 people here from different churches," said Mike Kahn, Executive Director of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association during an Ignite Event at the Idlewild Baptist Church.

"The training is so simple, biblical, and interactive, that I think many people will be changed from this day forward."

This movement is growing in underground house churches in the Middle East, churches in dusty compounds in Africa, remote villages along the Amazon River, and the churches in our communities here in North America. And people are coming to know Jesus because of it.
